

CASE STUDY PRÉCIS

Client: A major UK based shoe retailer with shops throughout the UK.

Project Type: 5000m² of Mezzanine flooring and relocation/addition of 2900 linear metres of Longspan shelving.

Project Size / Duration / Value: 5000m² / 14 weeks / £400k



Project Description:

Our client was looking to consolidate the products destined for sale at their numerous retail outlets with the products purchased via their website. Originally these two methods of sale were serviced from stock holdings at two separate premises.

An additional four units at the main site were sourced and mezzanine floors added to these plus one existing unit. The mezzanine floors were all designed for use with Longspan shelving that the company has used successfully for some time. New shelving was added to the scheme and, in conjunction with the shelving stripped down and transported from the existing website storage warehouse, the entire operation could now be serviced from one overall site.

Building regulations approval

All relevant consents were gained via our approved inspectors for the scheme and much of the initial planning and discussion of actual requirements were carried out during a consultation period before the project was actually initiated. This process enabled the customer to have a full understanding of his commitments and costs that would be required in order to gain full approval of the scheme.

All mezzanine floors and shelving were installed within the stated timescales and to the customer's satisfaction.
